Creative Drawing and Painting

If you like to draw and paint, through this course you will expand your artistic vocabulary, you will be encouraged to think creatively and to articulate in your work thoughts and emotions.

Students will learn to conceive drawing as a visual literacy tool, and the best way to observe and bring back to life the Prado Museum Masters such as Titian, El Greco, Velazquez and Goya, among others.

Students will paint and draw in the studio, in the city and in the Prado Museum, and will develop a unique artistic project based on their experience in Madrid. They will also enjoy the privileged and natural environment of la Berzosa Campus, where Nebrija University state-of-the-art studio spaces are located.

Art History in Madrid: From Antiquity to Contemporary Art

If you are fascinated by Art, visual narratives and History, in this course you will be exposed to an amazing and comprehensive overview of Western Art through fun and interactive on-site visits to world class Museums such as the Prado, Reina Sofía and the Thyssen Bornemisza.

Students will be immersed in the cultural movements, Masterpieces and stylistic changes that have shaped the History of Western Art, highlighting the importance of Spanish Art, including El Greco, Velázquez, Goya, Sorolla, Picasso and Dalí.

This course represents an exciting journey through art, human expression and history that will provide students with a repertoire of artistic references and a deep understanding of European Culture.

Madrid: Movin' Body!

If you love music, dancing and acting, in this course you will explore Madrid through the poetics of your body movement and expression.

You will discover the most emblematic areas of Madrid in a creative way, learning how you and your class interact with the space, architecture, smells, noises and people, being able to map the city through your experiences. The study of the city through the performative body implies an intuitive and creative journey in the territory of the stage and the audiovisual. Students will learn in the dance studio how to choreography their feelings and impressions of being in a new environment.

For their final project, Students will dance and perform to create audiovisual pieces which will show their unique and personal adventures in Madrid.

Character Design: Gods and Myth at The Prado Museum

If you like to draw comics, superheroes and create stories, through this course you will improve your drawing and analytical skills to design expressive, dynamic and compelling characters.

Students will learn Classical Mythology at the Prado Museum through the eyes of artists such as Titian, Velazquez Rubens or Goya.

As final project, Students will design their own characters based on what they've learned at the Prado Museum.

Spanish Fashion Culture

If you love trends, style, colors and observing the world around you, this course will enable you to broaden your aesthetic and creative vision.

Students will explore the connections between fashion, art, music, film and popular culture, through the rich past and multicultural present of Madrid, Europe's most vibrant Capital City.

Students will gain experiential knowledge through the development of an original Fashion project based on video making, drawing, reading and writing.
